Eligibility

- 1) Malaysian nationality
- 3) Posses Malaysian passport or willing to do so
- 2) University of Malaya undergraduate or postgraduate students who are currently enrolled in semester 2-4
- 3) Must be enthusiastic about environmental issues in Malaysia and other parts of the world
- 4) Demonstrate a good command of English (spoken & written)
- 5) Show evidence of good leadership and integrity
- 6) Willing to work with UMCARES in terms of environmental initiatives *(in or outside of campus) after the programme

All interested participants should submit;

- 1) A Resume/Curriculum vitae of your environmental contributions either in the university/national/ international level. Please include your details (e.g. name, matric no., ic. no., contact no.)
- 2) An original essay (written by you, details provided below) entitled "**Water Issues in Malaysia**" created exclusively for ASEP 2014.

Your essay needs to be;

- a) Written in English.
- b) One (1) page only. Margins should be 1-inch (left and right) and 1.5 inches (top and bottom). All essays should be typed in MS WORD format, single-spaced using 12-point Cambria font.
- c) Address the topic wisely.
- d) Proofread carefully. Your essay will be judged not only on the science, but also on creativity spelling, punctuation, and grammar.
DO NOT include illustrations, graphics, or diagrams.

Shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview. Please submit your resume/curriculum vitae via email to umcares@um.edu.my, **BEFORE or ON 14 March 2014 (Friday)**.
